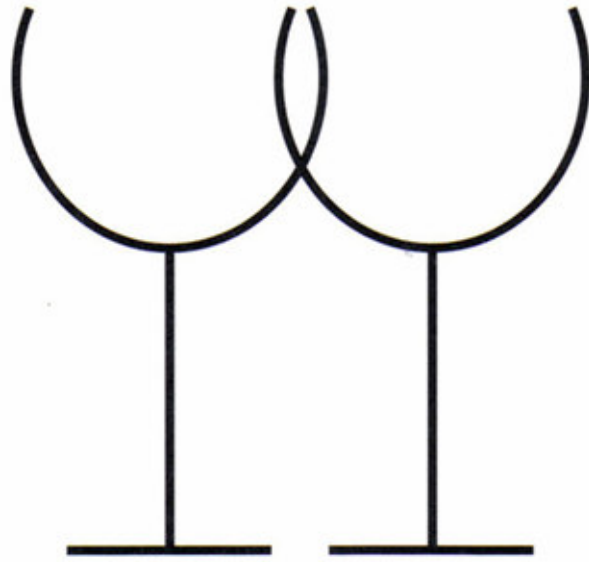

CATENA CABERNET SAUVIGNON, MENDOZA, ARGENTINA, 2005

(82/100 TANZER)

*This high altitude (the vineyards are at the feet of the Andes) 100% Cabernet is dark in color with aromas and flavors of black currant, blackberry, cedar, hints of herbs, espresso & graphite. It is ripe, rich, layered & lush in texture.*

DOMINIO DE TARES "BALTO", BIERZO, SPAIN, 2005

(90 WINE ADVOCATE & TANZER)

*Made from 100% Mencia grapes (a relatively unknown varietals from the northeastern region of Castilla y Leon) from 40 year old vines. It exhibits a saturated, dark color to the eye and chocolate & dark fruits on the nose. On the palate, plum & black cherry fruit are intertwined with espresso, chocolate & mineral flavors. The mouthfeel is rich & creamy, but not at all heavy and its tannins are concealed beneath the wines flesh. It finishes with juicy acidity and a recurring mineral note.*

ARGIOLAS "COSTERA", SARDINIA, ITALY, 2006

(90/100 WINE ADVOCATE)

*This Mediterranean red is based on Cannonau (known by most as Grenache). It is plump and rich with ripe, roasted plum and cherry fruit, notes of leather, tar spice and roasted peanuts.*

ZENATO VALPOLICELLA SUPERIORE, VENETO, ITALY, 2006

*This fine Valpolicella (a blend of Corvina Veronese, Molinara & Rondinella) has ripe red & black cherry fruit & floral notes, on the palate, it is all about creamy cherry fruit (dipped in chocolate) and a seamless and fleshy texture.*

069	<p><b>Jermann Pinot Bianco, Venezia Giulia, Friuli, Italy, 2006</b></p> <p><i>For those unfamiliar with it, Pinot Bianco is Pinot Grigio's more fruit-driven sibling. Silvo Jermann has been one of Italy's most prominent and best white wine producer for several decades, and it shows it here. This delicious, unoaked Pinot Bianco has a full range of citrus flavors, medium to full-body and a finish that is lively, refreshing &amp; long.</i></p>	56.00
560	<p><b>Patz &amp; Hall Chardonnay "Hyde Vineyard", Carneros, 2005 (93 Tanzer)</b></p> <p><i>Annes Moses &amp; James Hall seem to go from strength to strength with each successive vintage. This is a superb example of their handy work. The nose is quite nuanced with notes of lemon, custard, mineral, spice &amp; smoke. On the palate, its richness and fruit are balanced beautifully by the nervy acidity, mineral flavors and sense of terroir rare in California Chardonnay. Superb stuff!</i></p>	79.00
521	<p><b>Franz Haas "Manna", Vigneti della Dolomiti, Alto Adige, Italy, 2006 (90 Wine Spectator)</b></p> <p><i>This wildly innovative blend of Riesling (50%), Chardonnay (20%), Traminer Aromatico (20%), and Sauvignon (10%) come from a great producer in the Dolomite Mountains in Northeastern Italy. The grapes (harvested separately since they ripen at different times), are vinified separately, with only the Chardonnay seeing time in oak. They are then blended and matured on their lees for 8 months. It makes for a whole greater than the sum of its parts, nose of apple, lime &amp; apricot that echoes on the palate. It's medium bodied with apple &amp; citrus fruit, minerality &amp; racy acidity.</i></p>	65.00
155	<p><b>Alban Viognier "Alban Vineyard", Edna Valley, 2006 (92 Parker &amp; Tanzer)</b></p> <p><i>John Alban is already a living legend for his brilliant pioneering of Rhone varietals in California. This Viognier is to no ones surprise, one of the best examples of its kind. Its extroverted aromatics project ripe peaches, flowers &amp; brown butter. On its broad, rich palate are found concentrated flavors of peach, pear, peach pit notes, orange &amp; honeysuckle. Adventurous Chardonnay drinkers should take note!</i></p>	70.00
298	<p><b>Mastroberardino Fiano di Avellino "Radici", Campania, Italy, 2006</b></p> <p><i>Fiano is one Italy's finest yet relatively under appreciated (at least here in the U.S.) varietals. This medium bodied, unoaked white has aromas and flavors of ripe pear, lemon, anise, mineral, almond &amp; a slight hint of flint and salt on the finish. Chardonnay drinkers who would like a new experience should give this a shot.</i></p>	39.00
040	<p><b>Muller-Catoir "Haardter Burgergarten", Spatlese, Mosel, 2004 (95 Wine Advocate)</b></p> <p><i>This is spectacularly good German Riesling from a truly elite producer. It is rich and lush but not at all too sweet. Loaded with fruit that ranges from Meyer lemon, orange blossom &amp; yellow plum, it manages to combine a sense of honeyed creaminess with a stony minerality.</i></p>	72.00
831	<p><b>Mulderbosch Sauvignon Blanc, Stellenbosch, South Africa, 2006 (91 Tanzer)</b></p> <p><i>Fans of New Zealand Sauvignon should try this Sancerre-like beauty from one of South Africa's finest wineries. From its rather understated nose of gooseberry melon &amp; herbs, it develops on the palate with flavors of lemon, gooseberry, salty minerals, a rich &amp; lush texture and perfectly gauged acidity to provide balance and length. Understated class &amp; elegance in a glass!</i></p>	39.00

687	<b>Enzo Boglietti Barbera d' Alba, "Roscaletto", Piemonte, Italy, 2005</b> <i>This flashy little number is loaded with ripe dark fruit (blackberry &amp; black cherry), notes of bitter chocolate, tobacco &amp; espresso, rich texture, &amp; excellently integrated acidity. This is what modern Barbera is all about (Merlot drinkers take note!)</i>	<b>(90 Tanzer) 68.00</b>
719	<b>Neyers Syrah "Old Lakeville Road", Sonoma Coast, 2005</b> <i>Ehren Jordan (of Turley Zinfandel fame) has a great hand with Syrah and this might just be his finest to date. The aromatics of smoke, pepper, roasted herbs, etc... are tailor-made for Rhone officinados. On the palate, there is rich, dense fruit and meaty, truffley, peppery nuances, as well as polished tannin.</i>	<b>(93 Tanzer) 58.00</b>
269	<b>Villa Creek "Willow Creek Cuvee", Paso Robles, 2005</b> <i>A blend of 60% Grenache, 20% Syrah &amp; 20% Mourvedre, this Chateaufeuf-styled Paso Robles red is a winner and value. Proprietor and winemaker Chris Cherry has access to some of Paso's greatest vineyard source. He runs a fine restaurant up there too! This is redolent of ripe red fruits (currant, cherry, plum) spice notes, full-body and open knit but energetic mouth feel.</i>	<b>(91 Tanzer/90 Parker) 49.00</b>
570	<b>Arrowood Cabernet Sauvignon, Sonoma, 2002</b> <i>This is a very "establishment-type" wine for self-styled renegades like us, but Dick Arrowood has hit it just right with this lovely, balanced Cabernet. It exhibits classic black currant fruit with hints of chocolate, dried herb, good richness &amp; plush tannins.</i>	<b>(90 Wine Advocate) 68.00</b>
120	<b>Au Bon Climat Pinot Noir "Le Bon Climat", Santa Maria, 2005</b> <i>This is Jim Clendenen's finest effort yet from his own Le Bon Climat vineyard. 2005 was a terrific vintage for the Central Coast as this smoky, dark cherry scented Pinot Noir demonstrates on the palate, it has substantial richness, perfectly ripe fruit multiple layers &amp; very good balance. Bravo!</i>	<b>(90 Tanzer) 60.00</b>
573	<b>Havens "Bourriquot", Napa, 2002</b> <i>We have been long-time fans of this St. Emilion-style blend of nearly equal parts Cabernet Franc and Merlot. Bourriquot (loosely translated as "stubborn work horse" as a humble nod to the great Chateau Cheval Blanc) is about finesse, elegance and aromatic, not about size and extraction. That being said, there is no lack of either fruit (blue &amp; black) or flesh here, what really stands out, though is inner mouth perfume and nuances of menthol, minerals, tobacco and chocolate. This does not hit you over the head, but beguiles you by revealing its subtleties.</i>	<b>(91 Tanzer) 60.00</b>
456	<b>Les Bosquet des Papes, Chateaufeuf du Pape</b> <b>"A la Glorie de Mon Grandpere", Rhone Valley, France, 2004</b> <i>"To the glory of my grandfather" is the name of this 100% Grenache cuvee. The nose of this fleshy, opulent wine offers up scents of raspberry, boysenberry, kirsch, lavender &amp; anise. On the palate, the velvety texture and soft tannins support ripe berry flavors &amp; juicy acidity. Tasty stuff, pass the tapenade please.</i>	<b>(92 Wine Advocate) 95.00</b>
279	<b>Mauro Veglio Barolo "Castelletto", Piemonte, Italy, 1998</b> <i>Veglio is a disciple of the modernist school of Barolo winemaking, led by the great Elio Altare. He crafted perhaps his finest single-vineyard wine to date in this excellent vintage and 10 years of age makes it ready to drink. Expect good color, a nose of ripe cherry, anise &amp; herbs, and ripe currant &amp; raspberry fruit &amp; mineral flavors on the medium bodied palate. Ripe Nebbiolo tannins kick-in in the finish.</i>	<b>(92 Tanzer &amp; 92 Parker) 95.00</b>
024	<b>Poggio Argentera Morellino di Scansano "Capatosta", Italy, 2004</b> <i>Morellino is the local name for Sangiovese in the southern coastal part of Tuscany and this is the top of the line from one of the appellation's elite producers. This classy wine has a nose of ripe red &amp; black cherry, leather, spice &amp; smoke. On the palate, the classic Sangiovese flavors of cherry tobacco &amp; leather are complicated by notes of earth &amp; licorice. It is medium in weight with fine, dusty tannin on a long finish.</i>	<b>(90 Wine Advocate &amp; 91 Tanzer) 63.00</b>
