Au Bon Climat Chardonnay, Santa Barbara County, 2009

10.00

Jim Clendenen's 32 vintages of experience in Santa Barbara make him the region's wine making dean. This is one of his finest "villages" chardonnays with lees pear & melon on the nose, and an interplay of citrus & stone fruit with notes of oyster shell & wood spice on the palate. It is very well balanced, rich & lively.

Argiolas Vermentino "Costamolino", Sardinia, Italy, 2010

Pinot Grigio drinkers should taste this lovely Vermentino from the beautiful wind-swept island of Sardinia. Expect fresh unoaked tropical fruits with a lively interplay of floral, mineral & honey notes, crisp acidity & medium body.

St. Clair Sauvignon Blanc "Vicar's Choice", Marlborough, New Zealand, 2010 (89 Tanzer)

This is a lovely example of refreshing, intensely flavored New Zealand Sauvignon: bright color, pungent nose of mint, ginger & citrus zest, medium body and flavors of grapefruit, citrus peel, mineral & gooseberry.

Frisk Riesling "Prickly", Victoria, Australia, 2011

(88 Wine Spectator)

This whimsical, light, fruity, off-dry Riesling has citrus, pear & green apple flavors and just a hint of bubbles.

RED WINES

Catena Cabernet Sauvignon, Mendoza, Argentina, 2008

(90 Wine Advocate)

10.00

With a deep ruby color, nose of cassis, wood smoke and chocolate, this rich cab has intense red and black fruit flavors, notes of bitter chocolate, medium to full body, and ripe tannins. Kudos to proprietor, Nicolas Catena, winner of the prestigious Decanter Magazine 2009 Man of the Year Award!

Prunotto Barbera d' Asti "Fiulot", Piemonte, Italy, 2009

(89 Wine Advocate)

This bright, juicy red is a fine introduction to the pleasure of Piemonte's native Barbera grape. Expect a bright, medium red color, aromas of ripe red fruits and floral notes and youthfully vibrant raspberry & red cherry fruit on the palate. It is rather light in body with little tannin and juicy acidity. It pairs beautifully with tomato based dishes.

Au Bon Climat Pinot Noir, Santa Barbara, 2009

12.00

Jim Clendenen is one of California's Pinot Noir masters and this is a lovely example of his craft. The emphasis here is on aroma, finesse, and silkiness. You should expect bright red fruits (raspberry & red cherry) with notes of brown spices & floral notes. The texture is elegant with good flavor intensity, no excess weight or oak, and subtly floral notes on the finish.

Il Matane Primitivo di Manduria, Puglia, Italy, 2008

(90 Wine Spectator)

Primitivo is the Italian forebearer of Zinfandel and this notable effort provides ripe berry, plum & pomegranate, full-body, and notes of spice and oak. It is seamless & delicious.

Stolpman Syrah "Estate", Santa Ynez, 2008

(92 Tanzer)

13.00

With its gorgeous vineyards in Ballard Canyon, Stolpman has been producing really excellent Syrah for years. This rich, dark, layered wine has loads of dark berries and cassisfruit, with exotic spice notes, full-body, subtle floral notes and sweet tannins! Bravo!

458	<p>Abbazia Novacella Kerner, Valle Isarco, Alto Adige, 2009 (90 Wine Advocate)</p> <p><i>Kerner is a varietal brought about by an unusual marriage of Riesling and the red grape Schiava (a coupling akin to Julia Roberts and Lyle Lovett, but it turned out much better!). Expect a nose full of key lime peel, tropical fruit and minerals, which repeat on the palate. The wine is packed with fruit and is a lot of fun and satisfying.</i></p>	46.00
608	<p>St. Clair Sauvignon Blanc “Pioneer’s Block 18”, Marlborough, New Zealand, 2010 (90 Tanzer)</p> <p><i>This is classic Kiwi Sauvignon of a very high level. Completely unoaked, it boasts an expressive nose of grapefruit, lemon-lime and gooseberry. It is light, vibrant and juicy on the palate with lively interplay of citrus and mineral and a long finish. This is a fabulous match for Dungeness Crab or Crudo, not to mention a wonderfully fresh aperitif.</i></p>	38.00
699	<p>DeLille “Chaleur Blanc”, Columbia Valley, Washington, 2009 (93 Tanzer)</p> <p><i>DeLille has succeeded in a spectacular manner with this white Bordeaux doppelganger. It is 68% Sauvignon Blanc and 32% Semillon aged in oak (75%new) and oak treatment is beautifully gaged as to frame the wine’s fruit, not overwhelm it. Expect an expressive nose of toast, orange blossom, smoke and coconut. On the rich palate, expect an echo of the aromas along with ripe fruit flavors, a touch of honey, leesy complexity and a rather tactile mouthfeel. Chardonnay drinkers and white Graves aficionados should take note.</i></p>	59.00
977	<p>Stolpman “L’Avion”, Santa Ynez, 2008 (92 Tanzer)</p> <p><i>This delicious Roussanne is planted on a narrow limestone band in the Stolpman vineyard and is aged in large, rather neutral 500 liter puncheons (so to not mask the fruit and terroir). It is light gold in color, with a bouquet of citrus zest, quince, white flowers and a subtile hint of honey. On the palate it shows pear and citrus fruit, notes of jasmine and mineral. It is certainly full-bodied but easily manages to balance the richness with energy and cut. Chardonnay drinkers take note!</i></p>	64.00
418	<p>Donnhoff Riesling Spatlese “Schlossbockelheimer Felsenberg”, Nahe, Germany, 2006 (92 Wine Advocate)</p> <p><i>Helmut Donnhoff’s gift for making Riesling from the superb vineyards he owns is well documented among his competitors, who see him as a true superstar. This Spatlese is a fine example of his oeuvre (what would that be in German?). As for the wine itself, expect a youthfully light straw color & a stony, lemon-lime and red fruit nose. On the palate, you get a rush of, citrus, and passionfruit along with pungent, salty notes and a moderate sense of sweetness. It has excellent richness and fruit but what sets the wine apart is its minerality, and purity.</i></p>	79.00
065	<p>Tramin “Stoan”, Trentino-Alto Adige, 2009 (90 Wine Advocate)</p> <p><i>An innovative blend of 60% Chardonnay and 11% Pinot Bianco fermented in oak with 22% Sauvignon and 7% Traminer fermented in stainless steel. The latter two provide aromatic display elderflower blossom, apple, honey and spice, which repeat on the palate with a hint of banana, brown spice & minerals. It is rich and would pair well with rich fish & poultry dishes. This is certainly one of Italy’s finest and most distinctive white wines.</i></p>	70.00

	<i>This is text book essence of Grenache from one of Australia’s greatest wineries. The color is moderate red with hints of garnet at the edge (Grenache like Pinot Noir seldom gives off deep color). The fireworks start on the nose with musky, smoky red fruit (think Kirschwasser cherry liqueur) with a hint of white pepper & roasted peanuts. In the mouth, expect sweet, earth, ripe red cherry and raspberry (think Kirsch again), juicy acidity, ripe tannin and not inconsequential alcohol kick.</i>	
120	Au Bon Climat Pinot Noir “Au Bauge a Dessus”, Santa Maria, 2007	(91 Tanzer) 58.00
	<i>Jim Clendenen has crafted an elegant silky, perfumed Pinot Noir from this favored site. The perfumed nose shows red fruits (cherry and currants) along with notes of tea & anise. On the palate, expect medium body, silky tannin, plenty of graceful red fruit, mineral notes, juicy acidity and good length. This is a Pinot drinker’s Pinot, finesse and elegance over extraction and size.</i>	
166	Santadi “Rocca Rubia Riserva”, Carignano del Sulcis, Sardegna, 2007	(91 Wine Tanzer) 54.00
	<i>This Carignan from the beautiful, wind-swept island of Sardegna (Sardinia) is quite delicious. It has copious quantities of ripe black cherry & wild berry fruit fused to earth, spice, saddle leather, wild herbs and coffee. This pliant, meaty wine has lovely ripe tannins, mineral complexity and suavity to spare, (it’s a smoking value to boot).</i>	
956	Costanti Brunello di Montalcino, Toscana, 2003	(93 Tanzer & Wine Advocate) 125.00
	<i>This is a superb success the torrid 2003 vintage. Andrea Costanti has nailed it again with this beauty. The redolent nose has aromas of cherries & red currants, leather, & dried flowers & mineral. On the palate, ripe cherries mix with spice and floral notes on a velvety, lush platform. Tannins are ripe and there is excellent richness, but no traces of heaviness or over-ripeness. The achievement of such balance and finesse in a hot vintage is rather remarkable in our humble opinion.</i>	
372	Tinto Pesquera (A. Fernandez), Ribera del Duero, Spain, 2001	(92 Wine Advocate) 68.00
	<i>Alejandro Fernandez (not the Mexian singing star and son of Vicente, but the winemaker who brought the Ribera del Duero region to the wine world’s attention) is a master of Tempranillo and this is a fine example. On the palate, expect smoky, sauvage, chocolatey flavors wrapped around dark fruit. It is quite rich and dense, yet pliant with ripe tannins and lingering flavors. This cries out for a meat or mushroom preparation.</i>	
428	Mastroberardino Lacryma Christi del Vesuvio, Campania, 2008	(90 Wine Advocate) 41.00
	<i>This is probably unlike anything you have previously had. Literally translated as the “Tears of Christ”, this esoteric, Southern Italian red is 100% Piediroso grown in the volcanic soils created by Mt. Versuvius. It is a real value and <u>very exotic</u>. Count on a smoky, ethereal perfumes of red fruit with volcanic soil tones. On the palate, you will find it silky and medium-bodied with juicy red cherry and pomegranate fruit, an overlay of smoke, tar, minerals & distinctive soil tones. The texture might remind one of Pinot or Grenache. This is cool stuff for the adventurous drinker. It should be very flexible at the table.</i>	
479	Ravenswood Zinfandel “Old Hill”, Sonoma, 2008	(93 Tanzer) 79.00
	<i>Year in and year out, Joel Peterson’s Old Hill Vineyard (originally planted in 1862!) bottling ranks as one of “Zinfandom’s” finest and this is right on track, Expect a broodingly dark color, followed by aromas of black fruit, bitter chocolate & a hint of spices. On the palate, it is layered and rich with a downright creamy texture, loaded with fruit, with well-integrated oak (100% French, 1/3 new), and excellent balance The tannins are concealed beneath a wealth of fruit and flesh. Bomb, baby, bomb!</i>
