## SPARKLING WINE

### **Schramsberg Blanc de Blancs, North Coast, 2006**

**13.00**

*Schramsberg has been California's sparkling wine leader for 40 years!*

## WHITE WINES

### **Calera Chardonnay, Central Coast, 2008**

**(90 Wine Advocate)**

**9.75**

*Josh Jensen is one of California's Pinot Noir master and does a fine job with Chardonnay too. The nose reveals scents of green apple, honeysuckle & orange. On the palate, expect green apple, oyster shell, mineral on a medium bodied frame. There is lively balance between fruit, body & acidity with a little note of French oak (10% new) it's aged 10 months in.*

### **Argiolas Vermentino "Costamolino", Sardinia, Italy, 2008**

**(90 Wine Advocate)**

**9.00**

*Pinot Grigio fans should try this delicious Vermentino from the beautiful wind-swept island of Sardinia. This un-oaked, medium bodied wine has nectarine-like fruit, notes of almond & peach-pit stoniness, floral Aromas & refreshing acidity.*

### **Crios Torrontes, Salta, Argentina, 2009**

**(90 Tanzer / 90 Wine Advocate)**

**8.50**

*Torrontes is indigenous to Argentina and this is one of its finest examples. Pale in color, it has a beguilingly floral bouquet of citrus blossoms, anise & mint. The aromas are echoed in the flavors with notes of lychee, tropical fruits, lovely inner-mouth perfume, along with juicy acidity. It is light-bodied, dry, quite refreshing, and a real value.*

## RED WINES

### **Catena Cabernet Sauvignon, Mendoza, Argentina, 2007**

**(90 Wine Advocate)**

**10.00**

*With a deep ruby color, nose of cassis, wood smoke and chocolate, this rich cab has intense red and black fruit flavors, notes of bitter chocolate, medium to full body, and ripe tannins. Kudos to proprietor, Nicolas Catena, winner of the prestigious Decanter Magazine 2009 Man of the Year Award!*

### **Arcadian Syrah "Sleepy Hollow Vineyard", Santa Lucia Highlands, 2005**

**(91 Tanzer)**

**12.00**

*This full-bodied Syrah has a nose redolent of ripe, dark berries, spices, pepper & violet. On the palate, it expresses red and dark berry fruit as well as savory, meaty notes, black olives and hints of minerals. Tannins are ripe and chewy and juicy acidity provides vibrancy. Joe Davis is at the top of his game, and this richly fruited, structured Syrah from the much admired Sleepy Hollow vineyard in the excellent 2005 vintage is a real winner.*

### **Piaggia Carmignano Riserva, Tuscany, Italy, 2003**

**10.50**

*Carmignano is a tiny appellation right outside of Florence (Firenze), north of Chianti Classico. The founders managed to presage the idea of "Super Tuscan" by decades by blending Cabernet (20%) with Sangiovese. Expect a dark color, with an aromatic profile of bitter chocolate, ripe black cherry & espresso. On the palate, expect a full-body with, black cherry fruit wedded to bitter chocolate and earthy minerality. This burly wine is distinctly masculine and chewy and would best be paired with a steak, lamb chops or oxtail ragu.*

### **Paitin Barbera d'Alba "Serra", Piemonte, Italy, 2007**

**(90 Tanzer)**

**11.00**

*Sexy is the best word to describe this lush thoroughly convincing Barbera. This indigenous Piemontese varietal has deep ruby color, a rich nose of ripe black cherry & black raspberry and subtle notes of leather & chocolate. On the palate, expect terrific fruit (black cherry & black raspberry) and abroad, dense mouthfeel, plenty of energy no rough edges.*

418	<b>Donnhoff Riesling Spatlese “Schlossbocelheimer Felsenberg”, Nahe, Germany, 2004</b>	<b>(92 Wine Advocate) 79.00</b>
	<i>Helmut Donnhoff’s gift for making Riesling from the superb vineyards he owns is well documented among his competitors, who see him as a true superstar. This Spatlese is a fine example of his oeuvre (what would that be in German?). As for the wine itself, expect a youthfully light straw color &amp; a stony, lemon-lime nose. On the palate, you get a rush of pear, citrus, and yellow fruit along with a pungent, bright note of kiwi and a moderate sense of sweetness, after which, the fireworks begin. It has excellent richness but what sets the wine apart is its minerality, and purity. As lovely fruit excellent length and juicy, nervy acidity.</i>	
958	<b>Gini Soave “Salvarenza Vigna Vecchie”, Veneto, Italy, 2006</b>	<b>(92 Wine Advocate,90 Spectator) 62.00</b>
	<i>One of Italy’s finest white wines, this single vineyard Soave (90% Garganega &amp; 10% Trebbiano di Soave) is made from 80 year old vines and is aged in its lees in French oak for 9 months. Only made in excellent vintages, it is rich and creamy with aromas and flavors of orange blossom, peach &amp; citrus with complicating notes of almond, wax &amp; minerals.</i>	
766	<b>Alban Roussanne “Alban Estate Vineyard”, Edna Valley, 2006</b>	<b>(91 Spectator &amp; Advocate) 70.00</b>
	<i>John Alban is “the” Rhone varietal pioneer and master of our fair state, consistently fashioning superb examples year after year. This broad, dry Roussanne (with 25% Viognier for complexity) is an excellent alternative to Chardonnay, with loads of honeysuckle, pear-skin, tropical fruit, and classic bees wax notes. It should pair beautifully with rich fish, shellfish, and chicken. You will not be disappointed!</i>	
824	<b>Domaine Baumard Savennieres “Papillon”, Loire, 2002</b>	<b>(94 Wine Advocate) 65.00</b>
	<i>Domaine Baumard has exhibited an undeniable mastery of the Chenin Blanc grape in all of its styles (from sparkling to dry to dessert). This pure, unoaked, dryish Savennieres (one of Chenin Blanc’s most favored terroirs) is nothing short of terrific. The rich, textured mouthfeel has a panoply of aromas and flavors: poached pear, quince, white flowers, lemon-lime, terroirish notes of chalk, etc...</i>	
065	<b>Tramin “Stoan”, Trentino-Alto Adige, 2007</b>	<b>(92 Wine Advocate) 70.00</b>
	<i>An innovative blend of 60% Chardonnay and 11% Pinot Bianco fermented in oak with 22% Sauvignon and 7% Traminer fermented in stainless steel. The latter two provide aromatic display elderflower blossom, apple, honey and spice, which repeat on the palate with a hint of banana, brown spice &amp; minerals. It is rich and would pair well with rich fish &amp; poultry dishes. This is certainly one of Italy’s finest and most distinctive white wines.</i>	
458	<b>Abbazia Novacella Kerner, Valle Isarco, Alto Adige, 2008</b>	<b>42.00</b>
	<i>Kerner is a varietal brought about by an unusual marriage of Riesling and the red grape Schiava (a coupling akin to Julia Roberts and Lyle Lovett, but it turned out much better!). Expect a nose full of key lime peel, tropical fruit and minerals, which repeat on the palate. The wine is packed with fruit and is a lot of fun and satisfying.</i>	
889	<b>Patz &amp; Hall “Hudson Vineyard”, Carneros, 2006</b>	<b>(92 Wine Spectator) 62.00</b>
	<i>The husband &amp; wife of Anne Moses and James Hall have been making terrific Chard &amp; Pinot from some of the North Coast’s best vineyards for several years now. This is a fine example of their trademark finesse and elegant style. The nose reveals notes of crushed stone, lemon custard &amp; hints of hazelnuts &amp; leesy complexity. The palate is rich with repetition of the hazelnut character and good minerality and length.</i>

081	<b>Conterno Fantino Barbera d' Alba, "Vignota", Piemonte, Italy, 2006</b> (92 Tanzer) <i>This opulent yet very intense Barbera is loaded with ripe dark fruit (blackberry &amp; black cherry), notes of bitter chocolate, espresso &amp; minerals, rich texture, chewy but ripe tannin, &amp; excellently integrated acidity. This is what modern Barbera is all about (Merlot drinkers take note!)</i>	59.00
134	<b>Ramey Syrah" Rogers Creek", Sonoma Coast, 2006</b> (93 Parker, 94 Tanzer) <i>This is a stunning Syrah from a man who already makes some of California's very finest Chardonnay and Cabernet. In only his third vintage of Syrah, David Ramey has gone straight to elite status. This dark, full-bodied beauty has terrific aromatic of ripe cassis &amp; blackberry, notes of bitter chocolate, pepper and flower (it is co-fermented with 5% Viognier al la Cote Rotie). The lush, full-bodied palate is loaded with ripe, dark fruit, spices, pepper and a repeating floral note. It is seamless in texture and already complex. Both Cab drinkers and Rhone fans would be remiss to not give this a taste.</i>	79.00
326	<b>Havens Merlot Reserve, Carneros, 2004</b> (91 Tanzer, 90 Wine Advocate) <i>This is perhaps Michael Haven's finest Merlot in his distinguished career, and it delivers what Merlot is supposed to but too often doesn't, hedonistic pleasure. This downright sexy wine has a delicious, ripe nose of black raspberry, coffee &amp; bitter chocolate. It is open-kit and creamy on the palate with loads of sweet fruit and mocha. The texture is silky and seamless with the wine's flesh concealing its tannins.</i>	55.00
535	<b>Il Feuduccio "Margae", Montepulciano d' Abruzzo, 2000</b> (93 Wine Advocate) <i>This smashing wine, currently nearing its peak, is a superb example of the heights that Montepulciano can achieve in Abruzzi. It is wonderfully aromatic with classic notes of black &amp; red cherry, tobacco, leather, spices. On the palate, expect an echo of the cherry-tobacco-leather combination, full-body, silky lusciousness, resolved tannin and juicy acidity. Aficionados of Tuscan wines would be well advised to venture a little further South and give this a try.</i>	95.00
254	<b>Ridge "Geyserville", Sonoma County, 2006</b> (91 Tanzer) <i>Some flashy names and extremely ripe wines often catch more attention and hype, but Ridge remains one of our favorite Zinfandel producers (not to mention making one of the five or six consistently finest Cabernet based blends in California, the great Montebello). Winemaker, "Eminence Gris" Paul Draper, has been running the show for 40 years now, preaching and practicing a "gospel" of making balanced, elegant, age-worthy Zins. The current vintage of Geyserville is certainly representative of his credo. The final blend is 70% Zinfandel, 10% Petite Sirah (for structure) and 18% Carignane, and 2% Mataro On the nose, expect aromas of brambly berry fruits and hints of floral &amp; mineral notes as well as notes of licorice &amp; a hint of floral notes. The texture is polished and sappy without any sense of over-ripeness. Classy stuff.</i>	62.00
120	<b>Au Bon Climat Pinot Noir "Au Bauge a Dessus", Santa Maria, 2006</b> (91 Tanzer) <i>Jim Clendenen has crafted an elegant silky, perfumed Pinot Noir from this favored site. The perfumed nose shows red fruits (cherry and currants) along with notes of tea &amp; anise. On the palate, expect medium body, silky tannin, plenty of graceful red fruit, mineral notes, juicy acidity and good length. This is a Pinot drinker's Pinot, finesse and elegance over extraction and size.</i>	60.00
224	<b>Fuligni Brunello di Montalcino, Toscana, Italy, 2003</b> (93 Tanzer & Parker) <i>With perhaps the finest Brunello we have tasted from the torrid 2003 vintage, Fuligni has hit it out of the park. This Brunello perfectly straddles the line between typicity &amp; terroir and straight out opulence. The nose is explosive with ripe black cherry, tobacco, tar &amp; smoke. On the palate, it has loads of deliciously sweet fruit wedded to tobacco, earth &amp; spice. It is corpulent &amp; lush, with the wines flesh enveloping its tannins. This is sexy Brunello!</i>	110.00
