Buiten Sauvignon Blanc, Constantia, South Africa 2005

This is refreshing ,stainless steel fermented Sauvignon that has lovely fruit(gooseberry, kiwi, lime, and melon), medium body, racy acidity, and a mouth-watering finish. It is very Sancerre in style if a bit more plump. Delicious!

This fine Valpolicella (a blend of Corvina Veronese, Molinara & Rondinella) has ripe red & black cherry fruit & floral notes, on the palate, it is all about creamy cherry fruit (dipped in chocolate) and a seamless and fleshy texture.

Catena Cabernet Sauvignon, Mendoza, Argentina, 2004

(90 Wine Spectator)

This high altitude (the vineyards are at the feet of the Andes) 100% Cabernet is dark in color with aromas and flavors of black currant, blackberry, cedar, hints of herbs, espresso & graphite. It is ripe, rich, layered & lush in texture.

Bodegas Olivares "Alto de la Hoya", Jumilla, 2005

(90 Wine Advocate)

Always rated as a top value, this Mourvedre (Monstrell in Spanish) is from very old, ungrafted vines. It has a nose of roasted ripe plums & blackberries and hint of licorice & earth that echoes on its creamy, soft yet rich palate.

Mueller Syrah "Block Eleven", Russian River, 2003

This is big, rich, chocolatey Syrah that Cab drinkers will love: smoky blackberry fruit, full body, subtle notes of spice, good restraint and balance.

	<i>This is always one of Italy’s very finest white wines (it is a perennial Gambero Rosso 3 Bicchierri / 3 Glass award winner). It is a proprietary blend of the winery’s finest Sauvignon, Pinot Bianco & Tocai Friulano grapes, sourced from Felluga’s best vineyards (the high elevation ones hence Terre Alte). The Sauvignon & Pinot Bianco are made and aged in stainless steel while the Tocai receives it elevation in small French barrels. The resulting blend is rich but balanced with aromas and flavors of apple, honey, citrus, mineral herbs and hint of almond but the acidity keeps it fresh, lively, and long. Classy!</i>	
753	 Aubert Chardonnay “Ritchie Vineyard”, Sonoma Coast, 2002	(96 Tanzer) 110.00
	<i>Yes, we know that a Chardonnay at this price is an indulgence but we are fortunate to get <u>one case</u> (!) of this super wine. Mark Aubert, the winemaker that established Peter Michael, makes Chardonnays that ranks along with Kistler, Marcassin, Ramey, Kongsgaard, and (of course Peter Michael) in the California stratosphere.</i>	
416	 Kalin Semillon, Livermore Valley, 1997	(93 Tanzer) 50.00
	<i>Never a man in a hurry, the iconoclastic Terry Leighton is at it again: this 1997 Semillon is his current release! Blonde in color, it’s a romantics range from lemon, orange oil, wet stones to graham crackers and wax. On the palate, it is rich & concentrated revealing layers of flavor (lemon drop, honey, mineral & gravel-like stoniness reminiscent of a top white Bordeaux) This isn’t 10 year old, it’s 10 years young!</i>	
065	 Elena Walch Gewurztraminer “Kastelaz”, Alto Adige, Italy, 2005	(Tre Bicchierri, Gambero Rosso) 55.00
	<i>Fans of Alsatian white should take note. This is world class, dry Gewurztraminer from Alpine Italy. It has a gorgeous, classic bouquet of rose petal, sandalwood & lychee which echos on the palate, along with tropical fruit notes & minerality. It is well balanced and finishes dry, long & appropriately exotic.</i>	
561	 Brundlmayer Gruner Veltliner “Alte Reben”, Kamptal, Austria, 2002	(90 Tanzer) 69.00
	<i>This old vine Gruner Veltliner (Austria’s native grape) is a terrific alternative to Chardonnay. It has an expressive aromatic profile of ripe apricot, white pepper & minerals, full-body & flavors of pit fruits, fennel & powered stones. Fans of white Burgundy should give this Austria thorough-bred a try</i>	
324	 Failla Viognier “Alban Vineyard”, Edna Valley, 2005	(91 Wine Advocate) 59.00
	<i>Failla is Ehren Jordan’s (the winemaker at Turley) own winery and here he sources from the great Alban Vineyard. This consistently excellent Viognier has exotic perfumes of orchard fruit, white flowers & spices. Those aromas echo on the palate with plenty of body and richness but also underlying acidity that keeps it graceful & beautifully balanced.</i>	
031	 Brander Sauvignon Blanc “Au Naturel”, Santa Ynez, 2006	(91 Tanzer) 50.00
	<i>This is 100% Sauvignon Blanc chosen from the finest lots of the estate’s fruit, and made in the classic Loire Valley style. “Au Naturel” refers to the complete absence of oak (in other words, it is naked). The lovely bouquet of citrus, white flowers & mineral leads to flavors of Meyer lemon & pineapple intertwined with stone & mineral notes. It is rich yet racy from its acidity & has a sense of grip and excellent length. California Sauvignon doesn’t get much better than this!</i>

570	Arrowood Cabernet Sauvignon, Sonoma, 2002 <i>This is a very "establishment-type" wine for self-styled renegades like us, but Dick Arrowood has hit it just right with this lovely, balanced Cabernet. It exhibits classic black currant fruit with hints of chocolate, dried herb, good richness & plush tannins.</i>	(90 Wine Advocate) 68.00
553	Poggio Antico Brunello di Montalcino, Tuscany, 1999 <i>This is perhaps this fine producer's greatest vintage. The wine is clearly young but still approachable (decanting for half an hour is recommended). Dense & layered, it opens up to show aromas and flavors that range from roasted blackberry & cherry to spices, smoke earth, iron and leather. It is full-bodied and muscular thoroughly ripe tannins</i>	(92 Wine Spectator & Tanzer) 110.00
593	Luna "Canto Reserve", Napa, 2002 <i>We have been fans of this Cal-Ital winery (focusing on Pinot Grigio & Sangiovese) for many years now. This is their version of a "Super Tuscan", blending Sangiovese with Merlot, Cabernets Franc & Sauvignon & Petite Sirah. It is very dark in color, with an expressive nose of blackberry, chocolate, cedar & earth. It is full-bodied on the palate with good concentration, lots of dark fruit and hints of mineral, iron & anise. It is firmly structured & long.</i>	(91 Tanzer) 68.00
106	Castello di Fonterutoli Chianti Classico, Castellina, Tuscany, 2001 <i>This is an excellent example of this benchmark Tuscan winery's flagship. Once designated Riserva, it is now simply called Castello and it represents the finest Chianti on this estate. It is comprised of 85% Sangiovese (of course) with 10% Cabernet & 5% Merlot (as is now permitted under D.O.C.G. laws) to add a bit of extra flesh to the thoroughly Tuscan flavor profile (black cherry, leather, iron, tobacco). This rich Chianti has plenty of structure & good length.</i>	(91 Wine Spectator) 65.00
050	Avignonesi "Desiderio", Cortona, Tuscany, 2001 <i>Avignonesi has been in the elite of Vino Nobile di Montepulciano producers for years and this "Super-Tuscan" blend of 85% Merlot & 15% Cabernet Sauvignon is one of their finest wines to date. Generously endowed, this "Super Tuscan" provides the richness & fruit that people seek out in excellent Merlot. It is rather full in body & velvety in texture with flavors & aromas of espresso, bitter chocolate, black cherry, sandalwood, plum & a hint of licorice. It is simply pliant, rich & satisfying. 740	Vietti Barolo "Castiglione", Piemonte, Italy, 1999 <i>Vietti is a superb & consistent producer who seems to have just the right touch. This Barolo is drinking very well now and is a lovely introduction to the charms of the Nebbiolo grape. Perfumed on the nose, it offers lovely, elegant red fruit with floral & earth tones. It has a silky texture that belies the varietals usual tannic strength. In addition to all that, it is a steal in the category.</i>	(90 Wine Advocate) 65.00
581	La Spinetta Barbera d' Alba "Vigneto Gallina", Piemonte, 2003 <i>This is full-throttle, barrique-aged (100% New French Oak), modern style Barbera from a Barbera master. The excellent Gallina vineyard has vines that range from 35 to 60 years of aged and the crop yields are kept insanely low. What you get in the glass is a dark, rich, luscious wine packed with blackberry & black cherry fruit. Bitter chocolate, full-body, beautifully integrated oak & lingering notes of coffee, mineral & woodsmoke. Hedonistic is the word that comes to mind.</i>	(92 Tanzer) 78.00
592	Alban Syrah, Central Coast, 2005 <i>"Rhône-Ranger" pioneer & legend (living of course) John Alban makes some of California's most sought after and hard to get wine. We were thrilled to get 2 cases of the "village" Syrah (Albeit a "Village" wine that smokes most other producer's best single vineyard bottlings!). It is a dark fruit driven (Blackberry & cassis), well-endowed wine that also flashes the savory side of Syrah (smoked bacon, pepper, roasted herbs). Its structure is well covered by its ample flesh & fruit. This needs meat!</i>	75.00
